Senior product designer with nine years shaping consumer and developer-tooling products at high-growth tech companies. I lead end-to-end design — from research and systems thinking through high-fidelity prototyping and shipped engineering partnership. - Led design for Claude Projects, lifting weekly active retention 27% in the first quarter post-launch and shipping the artifact-share flow used by 1.4M users in its first month.
- Partnered with research and ML to define interaction patterns for long-context conversations, reducing user-reported confusion in usability sessions from 41% to 12%.
- Co-authored the Claude design language v2 — a 180-token system adopted across web, iOS, Android and the developer console.
- Mentored three mid-level designers; two were promoted within 18 months.

- Owned the v0 generation surface end-to-end, growing prompt-to-deploy conversion from 18% to 46% across two redesigns.
- Designed the Observability dashboard suite; cut median time-to-first-insight from 4m12s to 38s in moderated sessions.
- Drove the migration of 240+ legacy Geist UI components into a tokenized Tailwind v4 implementation, unblocking the Next.js 15 docs refresh.
- Hosted the internal "Design Critique Friday" — institutionalized feedback loop now run by the broader 38-person design org.

- Shipped Cycles, Triage and Roadmaps — three of the four most-cited features in customer churn-prevention interviews during my tenure.
- Reduced onboarding drop-off by 38% across iOS and web by reframing the empty-state pattern around "first issue" rather than "first project".
- Authored the keyboard-shortcut audit that became the foundation for Linear's Command Menu, used by 86% of weekly actives.

SELECTED PROJECTS

Claude Artifacts — Reimagined the inline-render surface so writers, coders, and designers could share live previews without leaving the conversation. Adopted in 62% of long-form Claude sessions.

v0 Streaming Composer — Visual layer over Vercel's generation runtime — keyboard-first prompt editing with optimistic, diff-style component swaps in under 200ms.

Linear Command Menu — Designed the contextual command surface that became the canonical interaction for the product. Now the most-used input across the entire Linear app.
